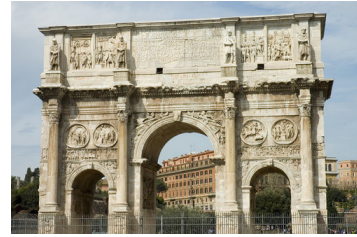


ARCHITECTURE
