1. 600 BCE –
Etruscans took
power in Rome.
509 BCE – Romans
drove the Etruscans
from power.

2. Rome creates a <u>Republic</u>.<u>Senate</u> – made up of patricians.<u>Consul</u>

Patrician: rich, upper class man

Plebian: ordinary citizen

3. Within 250 years, Rome conquers most of Italy, Spain, France, Africa (Carthage)

4. Trouble between patricians and plebians.

The Law of the 12 Tables: public laws that everyone had to follow.

5. Civil War
Julius Caesar
becomes a strong
military leader.

6. In 48 BCE, Julius Caesar becomes dictator of Rome.
